CASE STUDY: ECO-CONSCIOUS VENUE SELECTION

- Eco-Friendly Venues: We prioritise venues that use renewable energy sources, implement waste reduction strategies, and have water conservation measures in place.
- Sustainable Event Design: Event setups are planned to maximise energy efficiency, using natural lighting and energy-saving equipment where possible.
- Support for Local Economy: By choosing locally-operated venues and vendors, we contribute to the regional economy and strengthen our relationships with the community.







CASE STUDY: CARBON-FRIENDLY ACTIVITIES

- Low Carbon Footprint: Kayaking is a carbon-neutral way for guests to explore Krabi's stunning natural landscapes.
- Cultural Engagement: The kayaking tour includes visits to culturally significant sites, such as cave drawings, allowing guests to connect with the history of the area.
- Nature Connection: Guests paddle through areas rich with diverse fauna and flora, enhancing their appreciation for the local environment.
- **Health & Well-being:** This physical activity boosts guests' well-being while immersing them in nature.
- Community Support: By collaborating with local kayaking operators, we ensure that the experience benefits local guides and eco-tourism businesses.
